Tonnage at the Port of Green Bay remains steady in June

(Green Bay, WI) Coming off the strong month of May at the [Port of Green Bay](#), June tonnage numbers kept year-to-date tonnage steady, down just 1 percent from last year.

A lack of foreign imports of salt contributed to an overall decrease in imports, as did smaller shipments of coal. Conversely, limestone and petroleum products are up from this time last year. Domestic exports of petroleum products are up a drastic 508 percent.

“Domestic import and export, as well as foreign import and export of petroleum products continue to grow and move as a significant commodity in the Port of Green Bay,” said Dean Haen, Port of Green Bay Director. “Petroleum products include gasoline, diesel and ethanol, all vital products to businesses and individuals in Northeast Wisconsin.”

Two foreign vessels made their way into the Port in the month of June. The Emanuele S, sailing under the flag of Barbados, and Cape Dawson, sailing under the flag of the Marshall Islands, carried petroleum to and from the Port of Green Bay.
