I. Introduction:

- A. The Port of Green Bay, Wisconsin welcomes domestic (national) and international shippers.
- B. It is strategically located on the westernmost port of Lake Michigan (offers short direct routes to the Midwest and the World)
 - 1. Railroads and truck lines link the port with the Midwest Region and the rest of the United States.
- C. The Port provides a modern, state of the art facility for safe navigation and cargo handling.

II. Economic Impact:

- A. Green Bay is home to a variety of industries: (paper companies, calcium corp., cement co., oil co. etc.)
- B. The Port moves 2 million tons of cargo each year.
- C. Port cargo includes:
 - 1. coal, cement, limestone, salt, potash, tallow, petroleum products, and asphalt
